<p>G. ROSSETTI to Athens, Subject to Rome</p> <p>36. Around the middle of April 1942, Col. HEIDSCHUCH, who had just arrived from Berlin, took lodgings at the villa formerly used by ROSSETTI, at Via Manzoni, Naples. He was entrusted with the organization of a counter-espionage center at Naples under Abteilung III. Subject introduced to HEIDSCHUCH three Italian agents, whose names she can not now remember, who had been engaged by ROSSETTI but had never been sent on missions. Subject believed that HEIDSCHUCH engaged them, and that one in particular, a former NCO of the Police Force, who had been recruited at Rome, did some good work for the service. He was a Neapolitan about 50 years old. Subject states that she hardly knew HEIDSCHUCH but that she had heard that he was hated by all on account of his hardness of character, which eventually made relations with the Italian CE service rather strained.</p>
