

RESULTS OF THE 1966 ELECTION OF ESTONIAN CENTRAL COUNCIL  
IN CANADA

A total of 3870 votes were cast (about 40% of those eligible) of which 3739 were declared valid. On the previous election about 2800 votes were cast. E. Heine placed first (number of votes not available). *On the previous election*

First 35 candidates are considered elected, the others remain candidates. The by-laws of ECCC however permit addition to membership: 1. ex-officio members (former parliament members of Estonian Republic) 2. Delegates from other Estonian organization in Canada. This latter provision was rejected by voters effective 1969 with 1129 votes for and 2113 against. The provision was favored by "Nationalists".

The numbered categories designate individuals who received "Nationalists" endorsement in their pre-election publications.

1. This group came out as a block relatively early under the name of "United Assembly"

2. This group declared themselves "Independent Nationalists" advertising themselves also in "Estonian Courier" (Kärsna in New York). Of these Ilmar Heinsoo previously had not been classified as a "Nationalist". He appears to be a fence sitter type of an individual.

3. Individuals identified as "Nationalists" but who did not declare themselves with any of the above groups. Of these only Karl Molder appears to be a little known obscure individual.

4. Individuals who received last minute endorsement. These have not been previously classified as "Nationalists" nor did they declare themselves for any group (except Heinsoo)

Other candidates can be classified as "Non-Nationalists" in the sense it has become to mean disruptive group activities and attacks against others, support for Heine etc.). There were no declared groups or parties among these candidates.

*(Nationalists are)*
