Gleg Golubjalukov, 208 Village Drive, Syracuse, New York, an Electronics Engineer, General Electric Company, Syracuse, advised on May 10, 1957, that in the newspaper "Eesti Sona" (Estonian Word) he had read of the escape from the Soviet Union (Estonia) of Erik Haine, who is residing in Toronto, Canada, and whose whereabouts can be determined through the Estonian Refugee Committee in Toronto. Mr. Golubjalukov stated that this area is the one in which Russia's guided missile bases are concentrated. He stated that he noted Haine escaped in November, 1956, had been in Siberia twice, and had been associated with the Underground in Estonia for the last four to five years. He stated that the escape was remarkable because of the difficulty in getting out of the area and that this is one of the few escapees in the past several years.

Mr. Golubjalukov stated that because of the above facts he believed Haine would have much information of value to the United States.
