SUBJECT: 18 July 1963 Meetings with J. RAUS.

1) Undersigned met with J. RAUS in the DODS/SR s/h on 18 July from about 1800 to 2100 hours.

2. ITEMS DISCUSSED:

a. RAUS turned over approx 2500 cards on Estonian personalities from material furnished him earlier. He was given \$107.80 for passing to his wife for 49 hours of work.

b. Undersigned turned over to RAUS the following material for typing on cards:

- 1) 1949-59 Toronto Church anniversary.
- 2) Confirmants in the NYC Est Luth Church, 1962/63
- 3) List of approx 1000 names (with full biog data) on Estonian DP's in West German Refugee Camps.
- 4) IEL personalities
- 5) Residents of Sov Est

c. Additionally, RAUS was given the Tartu Univ Directory for his wife to translate.

d. RAUS was asked to give thought to Estonians at Cornell, Rochester, and NYU, Brooklyn Polytech, and Columbia. He could recall no one at the moment but promised to send the info if anything comes to mind.

e. On approx 15 Aug RAUS is going away for approx a month on duty with the DOB summer training program.

f. RAUS was instructed not to contact the undersigned in view of his absence except in case of emergency upon which he could communicate his message (s) to the undersigned's colleagues.

g. HEINE

2) The HEINE controversy still rages. However, HEINE's true colors are beginning to come out more clearly. RAUS reportedly that HEINE has now denounced

J. KANUR

as having been in the Soviet grasp as KANUR, during the first Sov occupation, had been dispatched to Moscow as an outstanding athlete.

3) The IEL group in Baltimore, with

Robert KUKLANE

at the helm, whom RAUS describes as nothing but an illiterate rubble rouser, has come up with the idea of summoning HEINE to Baltimore, with travel expenses fully covered by the IEL, in order to confront HEINE with the accusations against him and then to ask him if this is true. KUKLANE feels that HEINE would never lie to his classmates and fellow Estonians. The classmates who will be assembled for this confrontation will include, among others,

Julius KANGUR,

A. VESKE (see above),

and

Harry VESKER  
musician,  
lives Lakewood, NJ.

Further, KUKLANE has come upon the idea, probably even suggested to KUKLANE by HEINE (RAUS and others believe that HEINE is at the bottom of this), of writing to another classmate of HEINE, one

Heino AMERE  
lives in Soviet Estonia,

in order to get the most recent word from Soviet Estonia about HEINE's bona fides. If AMERE states that HEINE is bona fide, this will then be accepted at face value. Heino AMERE is the brother of

Age AMERE,  
lives Washington DC.

4) In regard to his denunciations, HEINE has mentioned to

Evald NAQI

that RAUS and VALLASTE should be removed from the IEL and divorced from Estonian political activities.

5. Reportedly,

Kimar LIPPING

, a former vice commander of the IEL and a former VEF employee, has taken up the defense of HEINE and has written to a number of individuals in Estonia in order to gain their support for HEINE as is represented by the E. NEEND group.
