MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 2 April 1964 Meeting with Juri RAUS

1. The meeting with RAUS occurred from about 1200 to 1300 hours over refreshments on 2 April 1964 in a Washington, D.C. cafe. The meeting was scheduled at this request.

2. Nothing of substance that was new was discussed at this meeting. RAUS, who is apparently still anxious of reassuring himself that the agency will come to his assistance, again inquired whether the agency would come to his assistance and what form the assistance would take. The undersigned gave the same answer which had been provided to him earlier.

3. There have been no new developments in the HEINE case and nothing has been heard about HEINE or his activities in Canada during the recent past. However, a virtual free-for-all occurred at the New York City chapter meeting of the LEL. The pro-forces were at the necks of the anti-forces.

4. RAUS returned to his earlier request that the agency use its influence to have DOD write him or the LEL a letter of commendation which he could then use in his anti-HEINE campaign. Before the undersigned was able to comment (there was no intention of ever presuming this idea of RAUS) RAUS stated that he had recently contacted his FBI contact after which discussion he wrote a letter to J. Edgar Hoover asking for whatever information the FBI had for or against HEINE.
