MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Heine vs. Raus

1. As a consequence of my discussion with Mr. Houston on 21 March, at which time I relayed the substance of my telephone conversation with [redacted] on 17 March, I called Mr. Douglas, Civil Division, Justice.

2. Douglas confirmed that he had attempted to reach Houston by phone on Friday regarding the Heine case. He stated while [redacted] had suggested an early meeting to discuss the aftermath of the March 11 hearing before Chief Judge Thomson, he thought we, working with [redacted] might wish to develop an Agency position in advance. He hastened to add that he was agreeable in meeting with us at any time but thought that such a preliminary might be helpful. I told him that we fully agreed and that I was scheduled to see [redacted] on Tuesday, the 22nd.
