MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT : Heins v. Haus

REFERENCE : Memo for [ ] dated 31 May 1966  
from [ ]

1. In response to my call today, [ ] advised that the call, described in the reference, had been taken by [ ] who on the evening of 30 May 1966 was performing the duties of Night Security Officer.

2. In discussing the incident with [ ], he said the call came in at 2145 hours. The individual spoke without an accent and sounded like a sincere, educated person. No particular reason was given for not giving the information over the phone, the caller merely stating that he preferred not to. As an explanation as why he could not be recontacted, the caller stated he was in the process of resettling himself in Virginia. The conversation was terminated with the individual indicating an interest in coming to this Agency. For contact purposes, he was told that upon arrival he could ask for a Security Officer.
