MEMORANDUM FOR: Mr. Bladergroen

SUBJECT: Heine v. Raus

1. On this date, [redacted] of Personnel Security called this office and advised that on 30 May 1966 the Night Security Office received a telephone call from one John Kelly. Mr. Kelly refused to identify himself further at that time, but advised that he was calling from the Washington National Airport and that he is in possession of information which may be of value to the Agency with regard to the Heine v. Raus case.
2. He stated that he has been in contact with someone (a third party) who has revealed to Kelly his association with Heine. Kelly further advised that his further association with the third party may prove of interest to the Agency. He, Kelly, stated that he is presently in the process of relocating and will reside in the State of Virginia. He also advised that for security reasons he could give me no further information at the time of the phone call, but that he would contact the Agency in the near future and would advise the Agency of the detailed information now in his possession.
