<p>1. Paragraph 1 of reference was passed to JAGUAR who have replied as follows:</p> <p>We have nothing recorded against Heljo Margarethe LOCK nee VARRES, nor her husband Maximilian Arndt Mardon LOCK. Heljo LOCK was born in Keeni, Estonia on 26 July 1924 and first arrived in this country as a hospital domestic in 1947. In 1949 she was employed at the Bethlehem Royal Hospital, Eden Park, Beckenham, Kent. On 31 August 1950 she was married to Maximilian A.M. LOCK.</p> <p>Lock was born in London on 26 July 1906 and his occupation is recorded as cashier. He and his wife have joint British passport number 658975 which they obtained in May 1963. They have one daughter born 29 June 1952.</p> <p>We have also ascertained that a certain Ilse VARRES, born in Keeni Ert, Estonia on 6 May 1923, arrived in this country in April 1947. She was employed in this country as a nurse and was also at the Bethlehem Royal Hospital, Beckenham, Kent for a short time. In 1953 her private address was given as 28 Swift Street, Barnsley, Yorkshire. Ilse VARRES left this country for Canada on 1 February 1957. There is also a woman named Hilja VARRES, born at Kuni, Estonia on 25 June 1927. She arrived in this country in March 1947 and in November 1949 married an Estonian named Arved VIIRLAI. Hilja VIIRLAI nee VARRES was also employed for a time at the Bethlehem Royal Hospital, Beckenham, Kent and after her marriage her private address was given as 28 Swift Street, Barnsley, i.e. the same address as that of Ilse VARRES.</p>

<p>It seems therefore more than likely that Ilse VARRES, Hilja VIIRLAID nee VARRES and Heljo LOCK nee VARRES are all sisters. Whether or not they are also sisters of Elsa HEINE nee VARRES it is not possible to say.
