SUBJECT: Operational/CART/BEDOX Marked for Indexing

Kurt HEINEMEYER - Returnee from Polish Prison

ACTION REQUIRED: COS for tracing and possible action.

1. Kurt HEINEMEYER (born 27 December 1907 in Hannover) appeared at the U.S. Consulate in Hannover in early October 1958. According to Heinemeyer he was a member of the Nazi Sicherheits-polizei and Sicherheitsdienst in Krakow, Poland, during World War II. He was imprisoned by the Poles on 10 August 1946 and released on 24 July 1958, although he still had at least three years of his sentence to serve. He arrived in Camp Friedland in West Germany on 26 July 1958 and returned to Hannover, his home.

2. While in prison in Poland, Heinemeyer allegedly became closely acquainted with four Poles and three Ukrainians who claimed they had been recruited by Americans in France and Germany, then trained in an "installation" in Frankfurt and subsequently infiltrated into Poland where they were arrested and jailed. They allegedly asked Heinemeyer to inform "Frankfurt" that the Polish Security Service have the names and photos of all individuals who went through the Frankfurt "installation" up to at least 1956.

3. The only names that Heinemeyer gave the Consulate officer were ~~from~~ NADDLSKI, who had allegedly been recruited in France, ~~STRYCZEK~~ and three brothers named NADOLNY. Heinemeyer allegedly spent close to two years in Polish prisons with them. When asked how the prisoners could have obtained the information, Heinemeyer said that presumably had learned it during their extensive interrogations by Polish security officers.
