1. Walter HENNIG born 24 July 1900 is listed in the Yugoslav Black Book. BDC traces should further expand this. There are also carded references to a Walter HENNIG who was an ANTIFA member in Camp 7275/7, Tarnapol and a Walter HENNIG residing in Herne at Hermann Loens Strasse 46, a Dipl. Ing. Beschaeftigt Architekt who was a member of an overt organization of the KPD in the British Zone. We cannot ascertain whether these are identical with Walter HENNIG of reference.

2. There are no traces on Bernhard LUEBBERING other than a carded reference dated 1944 that one fnu LUEBBERING born circa 1895-1900 was a Gestapo official.

3. The only reference to August ERMLER is that in 1959 he was a Criminal Inspector for the EKA.
