HERRSCHAPT, Hans,
born on 10 October 1919 in Gattenbrunn, Arad district, Rumania,
residence: Schneeglockenstrasse 73, Munich.

REFERENCE: Your letter dated 4 February 1955, and
our letter dated 9 February 1955.

Prior to 1939 SUBJECT was the leader of the Volksdeutschen (ethnic Germans) in Rumania. In the late thirties he studied at the Berlin Hochschule fuer Politik for several semesters, was a member of the Waffen-SS and a coverer of the SD (Sicherheitsdienst - Security Service).

In 1948 SUBJECT came to the Federal Republic as a refugee. Until 1953 he resided in Aachen, Maeldorf Landkreis; since 24 October 1953 he has been living in Munich at various addresses. His present address is Schneeglockenstrasse no. 73.

From 1950 to 1952 SUBJECT was a member of the Verband der Deutschen aus Rumänien (Union of the Germans from Rumania) and a co-worker of the monthly "Rumänische aus Westen" (published by that Union). In 1954 he wrote for the leftist paper "Deutsche Nationalzeitung".

Recently SUBJECT repeatedly participated in meetings held by the organization "Deutsche Nationalversammlung" (VDN).

Presently he claims to be a co-worker of the neutralist periodical "Neue Politik". He was present at the trial of Dr. Hans KAPFINGER in Passau, allegedly at the request of Wolf SCHENKE, publisher of the "Neue Politik".

Available information indicates that SUBJECT is making efforts to establish contact with various functionaries of rightist groups, without himself becoming active in these organizations.

The LCV requests to be furnished all information available in regard to SUBJECT, especially such concerning possible intelligence contacts.
