<p>a. The following two sketches give the pertinent details regarding [] and Dr. HILGER which you requested concerning those two. Obviously you will not wish to use all of this information in the preamble to such reports as you may issue, however, it is given to you as necessary background.</p> <p>....</p> <p>b. <u>Dr. Gustav HILGER</u> - a Career Minister in the German diplomatic service; born in Czarist Russia, the son of a German export-import merchant. He was educated in Germany and has spent the past 28 years of his life, prior to June 1941, in the Soviet Union. He negotiated the Stalin-Ribbentrop Pact and is considered the greatest living western expert on Soviet Russia. Dr. HILGER, who is 64 years of age, is now living in Silver Spring, Maryland. He is completely bi-lingual in Russian and German, and speaks very good English and French.</p>
