SUBJECT: STROBL/HODOSSY, Paul

1. Reference is made to letter, your office, dated 21 January 1949, subject as above.

2. The following information has been received from the organization re subject:

a. STROBL/HODOSSY, Paul is a member of sub-organization 114.

b. Sub-organization 114 answered the questions regarding connections maintained by HODOSSY as follows:

(1) Lajos (Ludwig) NADAS  
Nadas has been a Hungarian colonel in the general staff. STROBL knows him and there are friendly relations between both of them. Usually twice a month they exchange private letters. STROBL says he is no member and does not know anything about STROBL's present activities. NADAS is living in Lenzing near Voecklabruck/Upper Austria.

(2) BONIS  
STROBL does not know a person called BONIS, nor does any collaborator of his maintain connections with a person of that name.

Remark of ICO

Information was received from another source according to which a former Hungarian captain Bertalan BONIS, born 1913, is trying to get in contact with circles of the Hungarian Emigration. This source uttered suspicion that BONIS may possibly be employed by the Hungarian IS. Proofs are, however, not available.

(3) Dr. Lazlo (Ladislaus) CSETENYI

According to information from STROBL he was a Lieutenant-colonel with the police. STROBL met him in spring 1948 in Linz where CSETENYI then was the chief of a Hungarian Dp Section. He met him again in May 1948. But neither STROBL nor any of his collaborators maintain IS connections with CSETENYI.

In respect of the information that BONIS and CSETENYI try to form the centre of a Hungarian army it is remarked that both are not able to do this.

- (4) STROBL knows that a General Arpad HENNYEI is living in the French Zone of Austria. Furthermore he knows the Colonel General HENNYEI. STROBL has been instructed not to get with ZAKO again in contact.
