1. COS has a voluminous file on Emil Fridolin *HOFFMANN (Born 10 Oct 1911, Unglinghausen, Kreis Siegen, Westphalia, Germany) dating from March 1952 when he was involved in Berlin Interzonal Trade. However, most of this information is substantially the same as reported in EGBA-46637, 20 Dec 1957. COS wishes to defer further trace action on Emil Fridolin HOFFMANN to both Bonn and MOB. - a. Franz ~~ASCHENBRENNER~~. One Dr. Jur Franz ASCHENBRENNER, (Born 1 February 1912, Gutenstein, Kaernten, Austria) may be identical with Subject. COS files contain another card on one Franz ASCHENBRENNER at Getcheng/obb Camp (given as reference by Berthold GEISSLER, 529 ONONG, 29 Feb 52), no other identifiable information.
- b. Erwin Studienrat ~~FELLER~~. ^{W. Germany} Subject's name appeared on list of ^{CIT - West Germany} German nationals with whom Wilhelm ~~KIEFER~~, ^{Party in Germany} of Trillfingen ueber Haigerloch, had discussed his plans for the formation of a new rightist party. ~~KIEFER~~ is suspected of working for the French I. S., (MGFA-6628, 13 Aug 52). ^{Germany} ~~in Germany~~. ^{CIT - West Germany}
- c. ^{Germany} (Dr.) Kurt ~~HALLER~~. One Kurt HALLER (Born 26 December 1913, Betzdorf, Sieg) was connected with Abw II and responsible for Irish Affairs in 1942. PA to Veesenmayer in March 1944, when the latter became Ambassador to Hungary. ^{Germany} ~~May 1945~~, he was captured by the Americans in Austria (BAOR - CSUIC / WEA-89, 2 August 1946). ^{Personal Advisor to} ALSO carded information, (file no longer available) refers to CASABA-3.
- d. Waldemar ~~MUELLER~~. One Waldemar MUELLER of the Ministry for Light Industry (1 Oct 54, RVE-P72, 54). One Waldemar MUELLET, address, Essen Virchowstr 139; also Dortmund, Bornstr 315 (member of the Werner Naumann Circle (EGNA-2111, 23 June 53). One W. MUELLER, on personnel roster of the DDR Buro fuer Wirtschaftsfragen (office for Economic Affairs) as of 15 June 1952. (MGF-1079, 20 August 1952)
- e. Frank ~~SEIBTCH~~. ^{CIT - West Germany} Chairman of the Sudeten German Homeland Assn. Also deputy to BHE Bundestag. (EGNA-25607, 12 August 1955)

- a. Gerrit HUSSLAGE, ^{CIT-NETHERLANDS} Dutch citizen, resident of Berlin-Charlottenburg, Koenigen Elisabethstr 4. Subject attended a Moscow Economic Conference in 1952, but from all indications he is not pro-Communist and attended this conference strictly for business reasons. (USAREUR 594, 14 July 1953) ^{West Germany}
- b. Wolf SCHEMME resident of ^{CIT-West Germany} Harbachweg 107, Frankfurt A/Main, ^{West Germany} In 1952 Subject was connected with the Wilhelm KIEFFER Rightist Group. He was a co-founder of the Deutsche Kongress and publisher of news service "REALPOLITIK", also chairman of the Dritte Front. We have a voluminous file on Subject dating from May 1951.
