1. We regret the delay in replying to your request for information on Subject. Part of the delay has been our difficulty in contacting @ RISCHE of the UPSWING CE staff who was holding their card on subject.

2. Alias RISCHE indicated that Subject is not and never had been either an UPSWING agent nor a target. Subject of course has been of intelligence interest to UPSWING from time to time as he presumably has been to most major intelligence services. RISCHE indicated that the UPSWING traces on Subject had been summarized in their Memo 2079 dated February, 1952, a copy of which is herewith attached.

3. RISCHE went on to explain that his recent interest in Subject was purely peripheral and based on a BfV trace request directed to UPSWING in connection with the founding of the "Deutsche China Gesellschaft" (DCG) in Hamburg circa September 1957. The BfV was tracing the following senior officials of the DCG:

- (a) Wolf SCHEMKE
- (b) Herman SCHWANN
- (c) Eduard SOLICH

and noted further that Subject was listed among twenty-one advisory members of the Gesellschaft. The impression was gained that the BfV query was directed to @ RISCHE because of the DCG and the implication of a relationship of a sort with Red China.

4. We have no information in our files not otherwise available to you. For our information only we would be interested to learn if the DCG has come to KIBARK's attention previously.
