SUBJECT: HOLEIKO, Nester alias GOLEIKO

1. It is requested that your Bureau furnish this Agency with all information on Nester HOLEIKO alias GOLEIKO. It is reported that Subject, a Ukrainian, now resides in Detroit, Michigan, where he is employed as an engineer in a radio factory owned by a Czechoslovakian emigrant. He has a brother, (Dr. Longis) HOLEIKO, residing in Munich, Germany.

2. A usually reliable source has reported that Subject is a former Polish officer who was known in Innsbruck, Austria, as a Pole until 1951. It is alleged that HOLEIKO had contacts with the Polish Intelligence Service operated by General (Im) WISNIEWSKI in Paris and that he worked for the French Intelligence Service in Austria with his secretary, Zoniya or Sonya PAICHURA. It is reported that Subject emigrated to the United States in November 1951.

3. Further information on Nester HOLEIKO will be sent to your Bureau on receipt.

4. This is a request for a name trace only. It is requested that the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Immigration & Naturalization Service forward information on Subject.
