"c. HOSBACH is a small arms (small caliber) enthusiast and marksman, who together with his wife who is allegedly a champion marksman of some sort, was very active in local rifle clubs. He allegedly plans to continue this activity in Munich.

"d. He is very clever with his hands in woodworking and metal work and is an artist of considerable ability. In 1956 he presented the American Liaison Officers with sketches of local architecture which he had done himself and which he presented in the name of the SG at Christmas."
