The following information was taken, verbatim, from the above document.

1. It is requested that [ ] traces be furnished this office on the following persons, all of whom have been reported as being possible Rumanian I.S. or Cominform agents. Headquarters traces are furnished herewith on all except Lucia MILONE and Karl SCHARRENBROICH, both of whom are well known to you.				
a) Tiberiu HUMITA. A possible trace on this individual is contained in [ ] untranslated report PIR-4837. The report is concerned with various relief organizations coming under the jurisdiction of the National Catholic Welfare Conference and mentions the Rumanian Center, via del Babuino 149 (Greek Religious College). The chief of the Center is given as Jlio OLTEANU and the assistant chief as the Rumanian Theodore HUMITA (diTeodore di Abrudan ZINUCA), born in Cluj, Rumania, 20 Dec, 1913, student, living at Via Corvisieri 13, reported to have been in Italy since 1945 as a refugee.				
Another possible trace is contained in a recent report dealing with a Rumanian's comments on various other Rumanians in Europe and elsewhere. HUMITA (MUMITZA), fnu, is described as the person presiding over the Association of Rumanian Students in Italy (ASURI). HUMITA is a <u>Horia/Simist</u> .
