Reference is made to your memorandum of February 1, 1952, to the Displaced Persons Commission, a copy to this Bureau, concerning Tiberiu Humita, your SO DB 48419. Reference is also made to the report of Special Agent Clark Brown dated January 14, 1953, at Detroit, Michigan, a copy of which was furnished to you on January 30, 1953. *DFB-24141*

You will note in the report dated January 14, 1953, that both the subject and Constantin Micuda, an acquaintance, have denied Iron Guard connections and also their alleged connections with the Rumanian Legation in Rome.

Since investigation in the United States has not substantiated allegations made concerning the subject as set forth in SO DB 48419 and in particular those allegations to the effect that the subject was a Rumanian Intelligence Service agent in Italy, we would appreciate your rechecking with your sources for any additional or detailed information they might be able to provide concerning the subject. If these sources are presently in the United States and are available to us for interview, we would appreciate being advised.
