SPECIFIC- Tiberiu HUMITA

1. On 12 February 1952 the following information concerning Subject was furnished the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Displaced Persons Commission:

a. A report dated 18 April 1951, from a usually reliable source, advised that HUMITA, a Horia SIMA Iron Guardist, i.e., neo-Fascist, and leader of the Iron Guard organization in Italy, the Association of Rumanian Students (Comitato Assistenza Profughi Rumeni), had already emigrated and is now in the United States. b. A report dated 6 October 1949, from a usually reliable source, described Subject as assistant chief to Iuliu OLTEANU, chief of the Rumanian Center with offices in the Greek Religious College at Via del Babuino 149, Rome. Subject, at this time, resided at Via Corvisieri 13, Rome. He reportedly arrived in Italy as a refugee in 1945. (Based on PIR 4837, source,

c. Information dated 25 September 1950, from a usually reliable source, indicated that HUMITA was suspected as an agent of the Rumanian Intelligence Service. On at least two occasions, information given to him by Rumanian refugees soon appeared in the possession of Rumanian Intelligence Service agents. (Based on 6626, source,

d. In a report dated 26 November 1950, from a usually reliable source, Subject was described as head of the association of Rumanian Students in Rome. The association's political orientation was again noted as Iron Guardist. (Based on PIRA-7015,

e. On 26 December 1950, a usually reliable source, other than that of

paragraph d above, reported HUMITA as a Rumanian Intelligence Service agent in Italy. (Headquarters at this time cannot ascertain the basis for this information)

2. Subsequent to the information above, the Federal Bureau of Investigation advised Headquarters that since investigation in the United States has not substantiated allegations made regarding HUMITA as set forth in paragraph 1 above and in particular those allegations to the effect that HUMITA was a Rumanian Intelligence Service agent in Italy, it would be appreciated if the sources noted in paragraph 1 be rechecked for any additional or detailed information available regarding HUMITA.

3. Headquarters will appreciate your efforts in this matter.
