1. In answer to headquarters' request for information on Subject the following has been received from Source:
2. Teodoro Tiberiu HUMITA, son of Teodoro and of Zinca Alendan, born at Henz on 20 December 1913, stateless Rumanian, IRO passport no. 0022982, arrived in Rome on 14 January 1949 taking lodgings at 13 Via Corvisieri.
3. During his stay at Rome, Subject worked, as an employee, with the Pontifical Assistance Committee at 149 Via del Babuino.
4. No information emerges as to Subject's having had contact with Communists or with the Rumanian intelligence service.
5. According to a reliable confidential informant, Subject, an anti-Communist, was a legionnaire in the Iron Guards.
6. In 1941, after the coup d'etat of ANTONESCU, HUMITA fled to Germany and successively was interned in the Buchenwald concentration camp.
7. In Rumania, Subject was a university engineering student.
8. There are no unfavorable traces in Italian police files.
