<p>PERTINENT INFORMATION</p> <p>#2 Ten or twelve days ago Bidault telephoned Laiset, Prefect de Police, to make routine inquiry concerning welfare and activities Grand HUSSEINI. Laiset called back in half an hour to report situation normal. Later developments made it clear Grand HUSSEINI had actually left France three days before date Bidault inquiry.</p> <p>#3 Source commented above incident not to be taken as supportive of possible collusion on part of Laiset but as illustrative of general attitude French police toward Grand HUSSEINI who in past instances of police surveillance had received such close protection and so many favors from high grade d'oree officials that police ultimately become indifferent to his movements.</p> <p>#4 Same source said French government circles in general increasingly convinced escape was inspired and arranged by British.</p>
