- The following are included among the staff of the Grand Mufti at his present home in Haldiah (sic Ramleh?):
 - Rasem al-Thalidi Both of these men, who are close to the Mufti, handles financial matters; prominent Palestinian Arab.
 - Ishag Darwish
 - Haydar Husayni, in charge of public relations.
 - Munif Husayni, in charge of the Mufti's personal affairs; former editor of the now defunct newspaper al-Litha.
- Issa al-Darwish, a Palestinian Arab, and Hasan Abd-al-Said, the Mufti's former aide, both of Issa's village near Jerusalem, are also with the Mufti. Before the war, they were the chief assistants in organizing the Mufti's political terrorism against Arab opponents.
- It is reported that the Mufti now has unrestricted telephonic communication with Palestine and averages at least one call a day.
