"During the meeting of the Society for the Amalgamation of Islamic Sects in March 1947, Haj Amin HUSAYNI, ex-Mufti of Jerusalem, was present and expressed a desire to become a member. Said opposed the HUSAYNI's membership on the grounds that it contradicted the aims of the Society which were to keep clear of politics or any tendencies of bias against other countries. The majority of those in attendance approved Said's objection. Shortly after the meeting, according to Said, who trained the aims of Said's Society and added that he had had the same idea nearly ten years ago, but that circumstances had prevented him from putting his ideas into effect. He then asked why Said had refused to accept his nomination, Said reiterated his former reasons. The HUSAYNI agreed, but stated that his acceptance would win over all the Muslims of Palestine. Said's reluctance to accept the HUSAYNI is considered to have been genuine. Not until the matter was again put to the society's members was the HUSAYNI's membership finally approved."</p> <p>P.3</p> <p>"All these suggestions and allegations, contrary to Said's interpretation of his movement, have so far been neither confirmed nor proved wrong, and despite his reported association with the HUSAYNI and Hassan al Banna, the fact that a year has passed without any mention of his name or society in this area at least, suggests that he has given up the internal struggle of the Sunnis and the Shias, and that his society with its ambitious aims died in its embryonic stages."</p>
