Recent Activities of the ex-Mufti.

The attached report states that the ex-Mufti, whose popularity in Cairo has suffered a sensible decline, is trying to build up his contacts with the North African exiles, and is maintaining what a high official of the Arab League described to our source as "his vested interest in preventing the refugee issue being settled". Details of a squabble, during the Karachi congress, between the ex-Mufti and Said Ramadan of the Ikhwan, are also given in this report, which comes from []

It will be noted that this report provides some W 22-26549 confirmation of the information contained in our P/866 of the 30th May. Bashir Bey's hostility towards the Arab League was previously reported in our P/868 of the 23rd May, which was also from [] W 22-26322

RECENT ACTIVITIES IN EGYPT OF HAJ AMIN AL HUSSAINI,

EX-MUFTI OF PALESTINE

1. In recent months, Hajj AMIN ^{al-Husayni} ~~al-Hussaini~~, the ex-Mufti, ^{of Palestine} has come to realize that his presence in, ~~EGYPT~~ is no longer as welcome as hitherto. ~~The~~ Palace authorities have ceased to look upon him with sympathy; he is avoided by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and by the Arab League. He is, therefore, "lying low" but continues to accept all invitations to attend functions.

2. At every meeting he attends, the ex-Mufti is careful to assure those to whom he speaks that his only desire is to serve the Moslem cause throughout the world, and that he has no intention of interfering in the internal affairs of any country.

Reception in Honor of the Indonesian Prime Minister

3. Hajj AMIN AL ^{al-Husayni} HUSSAINI was present at the reception held ^{at the headquarters of the Muslim Brotherhood} recently at IKHWAN AL-MUSLIMIN H. Q. in honor of the Indonesian Prime Minister during the latter's visit to ~~EGYPT~~.

During the reception the ex-Mufti met and talked with ~~Abd al-~~ RAHMAN AZZAM (Pasha) Secretary-General of the Arab League; ^{Richard} ~~Abd al-~~ AL-FAY, leader of the Istiqlal Party of MOROCCO; and ^{Salih} ~~Abd al-~~ HARB Pasha, President of the ^{Young Men's Muslim Association (Y.M.M.A.)} ~~Arab League~~, but made no speech himself.

4. HASSAN ISMAIL ~~Abd~~ HUDAIBI Bey, Supreme Guide of the IKHWAN AL-MUSLIMIN, spoke of the need for unity of the Moslem world in order to remove the evils of poverty and ignorance. ~~He was,~~ However, ~~at pains~~ to make it plain that he did not advocate the supersession of the Arab League.

personal intervention of Haj AMIN with ^{the ex-Mufti,} SAUD HAD Pasha, the President of the K.M.K.A. Furthermore, ~~SAUD HAD~~ ^{SAUD HAD} was persuaded by the ex-Mufti to appoint ~~ABDUL SHARAF~~ ^{ABDUL SHARAF} to represent the K.M.K.A. at the next Moslem Congress in KARACHI.

9. In a recent discussion on the ^{unresolved} ~~pending~~ ^{the ex-Mufti} ~~case~~ of the Palestine Arab refugees, Haj AMIN stated that he and the Arab Higher Committee would actively work against any permanent settlement between ISRAEL and the Arab States until the question of compensation and repatriation of these refugees had been satisfactorily settled. Provided ^{that} ~~the~~ ^{with} ~~the~~ compensation ^{was} ~~was~~ forthcoming from ISRAEL, the ex-Mufti said he would agree to those refugees who wished to do so and who were acceptable to the States concerned, remaining in SYRIA, IRAQ, SAUDI ARABIA, and the LEBANON.

10. Commenting on this statement, a high official in the Arab League gave vent to the following illuminating sarcasm:-

"Certainly Haj AMIN and his gang have a vested interest in preventing the case of these unfortunates from being settled, for as long as this continues it affords them an excuse to exploit the various Arab and Islamic nations and swindle money out of them."
