- The ex-Grand Mufti Hajj Amin al-Husayni prolonged his stay in Lebanon from 6 until 10 October as the result of a message received from Col. Adib Shishakli of Syria. The message was delivered (by an unspecified individual) at the home of Raja'i Husayni in Beirut.
- On 6 October the Mufti visited President Shem'un, who promised to pay to the Arab Higher Executive (AHE) the monthly sum of 2000 Lebanese pounds which Bisharah al-Khuri had paid in the past.¹ The Mufti also visited most of the Lebanese Moslem deputies and leaders, notably Sami Sulh, 'Abdullah al-Yafi, Bizzi (fnu),² Da'ug (fnu),³ and Rashid Karamah, for the purpose of trying to get them to unite in their Lebanese political activities.
- At the request of Muhammad Nimr Awdash, the Mufti took Amil Ghuri back to Cairo with him on 10 October 1952. 'Abdullah Samarah was appointed "Chargé d'Affaires" of the AHE Committee to replace Ghuri, with Hajj Khalid Farik as his assistant.
