On 2 November 1952, Amil al-Ghuri (former Secretary of the Arab Higher Committee) made the following observations on the German-Israeli Compensation Agreement:

- a. The Arab countries believe that the German-Israeli Compensation Agreement was effected by American influence with the approval of the French and British Governments.
- b. They also believe that the agreement is really a long-range plan for indirect American aid to Israel, because Germany is not financially able to pay all the compensations.
- c. The agreement's aim is to counteract the boycott of Israel by the Arab countries. As a result, these countries may be forced to agree to a peaceful settlement of the Palestine problem.
