The Ex-MUFTI's Finances. October 1952.

The following is a summary of a pamphlet received late in October by a Jordan supporter of the ex-MUFTI of JERUSALEM. It is headed "a Memorandum from the Arab Higher Committee for Palestine", and dated 13th October 1952 at CAIRO.

(a) Exaggerated versions concerning the revenues of Haj AMIN al-HUSAINI have been published in some papers following the recent meeting of the Arab League.

(b) The Arab Higher Committee did in fact receive from Pakistan the following by way of voluntary contributions : in 1948 the sum of £E 24,281 and 250 mils; in 1951 the sum of £E 24,281 and 245 mils. This money was received from the people of Pakistan by way of the Pakistani government.

(c) These contributions have already been expended on refugees and in matters connected with the Palestine problem.
