1. Shaykh Abd al Jassin al Qashani recently wrote a letter to Faiq 'Annabawi and Faysal Nabulsi, two ardent supporters of the Ex-Mufti in Nablus. Qashani stated in the letter that they were recommended to him by Ex-Mufti Haj Amin al Husayni as being capable of assisting him in the selection of four good hard-working Jordanian Moslems known to have no connection with either the British or the Americans.
2. Qashani further explained that the four selected individuals will be invited to attend a Moslem religious assembly to be held in Teheran in the near future.
