1. Hajj Amin al-HUSAYNI, ex-Grand Mufti of Jerusalem, left Damascus for Tripoli, Lebanon, on 23 September 1956. He was expected to spend five to six days in Lebanon visiting ^ALebanese leaders and Palestinian refugees.
2. Hajj Amin travelled in an automobile with Jordanian license plates No. 1068.

Station Comment: The most recent report on HUSAYNI's activities in Syria was NSD-910.
