Latest Sitrep on
Radio Project

1. During our recent trip to Vienna, February 17-18, we discussed the latest developments affecting and 's status in our ICEBERG program with , and . has summarized developments to date in his Agent Progress Report. You can review this by referring to page 5 of MAVA 2410 dispatched from Vienna on or about 1 February. It was agreed upon by all concerned that 's aberration prevents him from being used as a sleeper radio agent. The equipment which was turned over to him has been dug up and is in possession of . As indicated in the above references plans QBST were never turned over to subject. we understand, will be retained for intelligence gathering work. Only in the event of our sudden departure from Vienna and in the case other stay-behind agents would not have been trained would he revert to his original role as a radio operator for the ICEBERG program. We appreciate whatever comments you might have to make on this when you have had an opportunity to review all pertinent data.

2. and dug up the cache prepared for . We found all the equipment in remarkably good condition. We put the receiver to test and found it operating satisfactorily. We noted that there was some condensation of moisture on the line voltage meter of the power pack which evaporated during the test. We did not attempt to tune the transmitter inasmuch as we had no crystal at our disposal and assumed that it was in the same condition as the other two elements of the set. has prepared a memorandum on the "disinternment" and we are arranging to have a copy for your information.
