1. A copy of ERFN 8360 has been forwarded to   Station  
principally because of the comments contained therein which relate to  
AEMARSH/15.

2. We have not been able to tie in the information contained in  
the separate cover attachment to OSSA 8580 with the dispatch itself.  
The thought has occurred to us that the separate cover attachment may  
possibly represent biographic data on AEMARSH/15's internal contacts  
to whom he periodically mails relief packages. Should this supposition  
be correct, it represents information on individuals which, heretofore,  
are unknown to us. In any event, your clarification is requested.  
We wish to suggest that it seems advisable to have AEMARSH/15 prepare  
a detailed list of those individuals in Latvia with whom he is in  
contact, along with as much biographic data as he is able to provide.
