Resides: Tukuma Rajons, Pliema Ciems, Latvia, Russia.

2. However, Bonn Base files contain carded information which reveals that one

Voldemars *ALKSNIS
DPOB: 26 August 1898 in Latvia
Last known address: Latvian Labor Service Co., Kairserlauten
was dropped on 28 February 1953 without prejudice by intelligence agencies
in the U.S. Zones of Germany and Austria. It could be possible that he is
related to Lizete.

3. We have not traced Subjects with Liaison because, as stated in EGNA-15582,
7 August 1958 (not sent to SR) our traces with the BfV are made on a case-
to-case basis. However, if SR desires to provide us with a list of names,
including Subjects, and a suitable pretext for our query, we shall be happy
to initiate traces with the BfV.
