1. AEMARSH/15 transmitted one picture of (Attachment A) and one picture of (Attachment B) to in late 1958 or early 1959. AEMARSH/15 reportedly received both of the above photos from in early 1958 via overt mail from Latvia.

2. In 1960 When contacted by KUBARK and shown the above photographs of the individual we had believed to be she stated that these were not photos of her brother-in-law. furnished KUBARK a single picture of (Attachment C) and a picture of (Attachment D), taken in 1960.

3. FYI: The man in Attachments C and D has been firmly identified as by a Headquarters' source who had known this man quite well at one time.
