1. CATIDE is requesting a Berlin Document Center check on the following individuals whom we know or believe to be CATIDE staffers, contacts or sources. It is requested that not only documents reflecting Subjects' membership in Nazi organizations be forwarded, but that copies of all documents reflecting their educational, professional or other personal history up to May 1945 be included. In connection with our UJVAEURE program we are also requesting traces on these individuals at this time.

Subject began working for CATIDE prior to September 1951. Initially a spotter in a DP camp in Graz, he subsequently became a sub-agency leader for Dienststelle 2, which had targets in Austria, Hungary, and the Balkans. In June 1954 he was arrested in Vienna, and materials suggesting CATIDE efforts to penetrate Austrian Government agencies were found in his possession. EAVA-21783, 24 February 1959, reports KAINZ's "resignation" from CATIDE in order to retain his Austrian citizenship and work for GRENSOAP. But MUNI 50.0. 25 June 1959 reports the statement of  that KAINZ had been dropped by CATIDE for security reasons. The last reference to KAINZ in Munich files is a paragraph of EAVA-24561, 1 February 1960, which reported that he was GRENSOAP-10, relatively unknown to Americans who were in contact with his agent,  According to EAVA-21783, KAINZ had belonged to the RSDAP.
