OO-B-10676-49, 13 Dec 49 - Member of Parliament, M of Latvian Central Council in exile, M of Central Committee of the Latvian Social Dem Party in exile, M of Central Committee of Latvian Resistance Movement under German occupation, M of Permanent Bureau of Socialists in exile, former lecturer at Univ of Riga. Representative of Lat Social Dem Party of Latvian National Council of European Movement.

WSSA - 192 says that Subj is Chairman of a Latvian Central Council (LCP) which is described as a political organization developed from the underground movement in 1943-44. Subj together with its other members Mintauts CHAKSTE, Felix CIELENS, and ex-Minister SALNAIS, are said to meet regularly at the home of SALNAIS. The Latvian Central Committee, located at Vastmannagatan 13, Stockholm, is described as a non-political organization assuming more or less the duties of a consulate and recognized by the Swedish authorities as representing the interests of Latvian refugees. It is headed by Janis BREIKS. 67-7-6-15

TX-832, 17 May 1946 uses the terms "Central Council" and "Central Committee" synonymously. It lists eleven members of the Council or Committee, including KALNINS as President and BREIKS as Vice President.

French source of OPC (QZ/362, 17 Nov 50) reports that Balts state some concern in Ba emigre circles at action of K., who is charged with making unnecessary revelations of emigre activities and "denouncing" certain emigres to the foreign section of the Br Labour Party. It was stated by the aforementioned Balts that these actions are embarrassing to Lat Min in London who has direct contact with Br Foreign Office. Situation has developed to a point where it is of interest to emigre organizations of the other Ba States.
