Case of Bruno KALNINS

Reference is made to your memorandum of November 12, 1954 received in this office November 22, 1954 enclosing a copy of a report of ~~October 27, 1954~~ from the Central Intelligence Agency stating that one Bruno Kalnins, a resident of Stockholm, Sweden, intended to visit the United States to attend on November 7, 1954 the Assembly of Captive European Nations in New York. Since it appeared that Mr. Kalnins presence at the Assembly would adversely effect the harmonious cooperation among the emigres, the Central Intelligence Agency requested that it be advised of the action taken in this case.

In reply to an inquiry directed to the American Embassy at Stockholm, Sweden, this office has now been informed that the files of the Embassy fail to disclose any record of the issuance of a visa to Mr. Kalnins or any indication that he has applied or intends to apply for one.
