We were recently contacted by [redacted] with regard to a possible financial grant to your Soviet Research Group by [redacted] to enable you to meet certain needs in your program. [redacted] indicated these needs to be mainly additional library materials and special lectures by qualified Western experts. He estimated that a grant of \$1200 would enable you to improve your program considerably.
