1. SOB files revealed no traces on either Franz KARVASIN or Karol GINDL.

2. G-2 files contained a SNEAP card on (Ing.) Franz KARVASIN. The information on this card is summarized in the attached CIC report dated 4 November 1946. Attached also are four other 1946 CIC reports on Ing. Franz KARVASIN.

3. Information from CIC (no date given) on Karol GINDL stated he was born 21 April 1911. He uses the aliases Jan KARWATI, Karol MAJER and Karol NAGY. His last known address was Berlin. He had been employed by the FIS and was dropped 15 July 1954 for security reasons, disobedience and neglecting his duties.
