3. REPORT OF FINDINGS

On 1 April 1953 the mail of Richard KAUDER-KLATT, Schwarzstrasse 30, Salzburg, Land Salzburg, Austria, was intercepted by the Civil Censorship Group (CCG) in Austria. On that date SUBJECT received a personal letter from Victor Macellan, Stiftstrasse 7, Frankfurt/Main, Germany. The CCG intercept, in the English language as received from CCG, is retained in the files of this Sub-Detachment. A copy of the intercept is attached to each copy of this report as EXHIBIT 1. In EXHIBIT 1 Victor Macellan informed SUBJECT that "... I am not recovering from the sickness," and "I hesitate whether I am to wait here or go to London in order to undergo an operation and I now come to a decision. I will go to London and only will take care of some urgent business here". In the letter Macellan also stated "... I am really very s.o.k. Dr. Foerster in Salzburg ... is thoroughly informed of my case...". The letter was concluded with Macellan's statement, "I will write you from London at once. I hope that we will see each other very soon".

On 13 April 1953 the files of the 430th CIC Sub-Detachment A were examined by this Agent for information concerning SUBJECT with the following results:

Richard KAUDER-KLATT is mentioned in Agent Report, S-16916, dated 2 March 1953, Subject as above, and in numerous other reports as a former German Intelligence agent currently suspected of being involved in Israeli Intelligence activities (Evaluation C-3)

Agent's Notes: On 13 April 1953 the files of this Sub-Detachment were examined for information concerning the other personalities mentioned in this report with the following results:

Victor <sup>Altman</sup> Altmann alias Victor Macellan is mentioned in Agent Report, S-12857, dated 21 February 1952, Subject: Altmann, Victor, British Intelligence Operative, and numerous other reports as a British Intelligence and "Eisenhower Intelligence Service" operative. (No evaluation)

The files of this Sub-Detachment revealed no information regarding Dr. Foerster, currently residing in Salzburg; however, numerous Drs. Foersters, who are Vienna residents, are included in the files.

I hesitated whether I am to wait here or go to London in order to undergo an operation and I now came to a decision. I will go to London and only will take care of some urgent business matters here.

Referring to your inquiry concerning the amounts spent for the business it goes without saying that the expenses will be refunded to you - but you will have to wait until I am healthy again.

No, nobody wants to take my place, I started the business and therefore I will have to transact it. As a precaution I wrote you to stop it because suffering from this awful disease and blood clotting I don't know what will happen in the next days.

I hope that after having recovered from my sickness I will be able to start again a business transaction with you. Therefore I have to be patient. I don't want to make excuses, I am really very sick. Doctor FOKRSTER in Salzburg who is thoroughly informed of my case and the gentleman from the hospital in Munich on the right side of the Isar wanted to operate me in any case. I will write you from London at once, I hope that we will see each other very soon.
