1. When [ ] was in Karlsruhe on 4 November 1950 he gave [ ] information about the possibility of recruiting KIBITZ personnel through the daughter of Hermann DRYER a former senior official of I.G. Farben, who is now a buyer for the DAYER (BAYER?) works in Leverkusen.
