KIBITZ Documentation

1. We know that the problem of false documentation for KIBITZ personnel has not escaped your attention, although the multiplicity of your other KIBITZ problems has probably prevented you from formulating definite plans on this subject. The suggestion in MEM-1-1477 that one agent be recruited for the specific purpose of documenting the false backgrounds necessary to support the false identities given to KIBITZ agents seems good to us here. The details of how this agent would be able, with adequate security to our operations, to assume the many identities necessary are not clear to us, and we should appreciate a statement of your plans as soon as possible.

2. We do not need to point out to you that it is of extreme importance to build up appropriate false backgrounds for all KIBITZ Phase A personnel in order that they may go under cover with the minimum danger and maximum speed. They will all have to prepare false background stories with you so that you can work out the story best suited for each in accordance with your and their possibilities for documenting that story.

3. In this connection it might be possible to use the or other police sources to furnish necessary blank forms and to insert false records in official files.
