KIBITZ Agent Training

1. KIBITZ 180, presently in final training, is scheduled for completion on 20 or 21 March with the regular field problem as a final exercise. Now we have just received word that his team leader, KIBITZ 128, might also be able to get away from work at this same time. This appears to present an opportune occasion to attempt a complete field training problem of having the team make actual OB observations, write up their reports and simulate transmission.

2. In order to assure us of being able to make profitable observations in the limited time available for the problem, clearances for freedom of movement on the military reservations (Grafenwohr and Furstenfeldbruck in this case) should be obtained. Further, it would be desirable to have a trained military observer assigned as guide in this first exercise.

3. Headquarters support in expediting the needs of paragraph 2 is requested.
