SUBJECT: Briefing of [] on Clandestine Radio Communications Equipment.

1. [] received instruction in the basic technical and manual operation and field maintenance of the RS-1, RS-5, RS-6 and URC/4 agent type radio sets and the SSP-11 and SSP-12 emergency power generating equipment. Also provided was a discussion on radio wave propagation frequency prediction, antenna radiation and construction, purpose, use and security aspect of clandestine type signal plans and operating procedures.

2. As a result of the above briefing, [] is familiar with the general aspects of clandestine communications and the equipment necessary to provide such communications. He is not considered qualified to operate or to engage in the instruction of field radio operators.
