In reviewing our organizational charts and files, several questions have occurred which we would appreciate having you answer after you have had an opportunity to become thoroughly familiar with your new show:

- a. We have the numbers of KIBITZ 15 agents beginning with 101 and ending with the most recent number - 198. However, we are wondering whether you have some of the names which we do not have. We have all of the real names except for the following: 101 through 107, 110, 111, 119, 120, 125, 126, 131, 136, 141 through 145, 172 through 176, 178, 179, 181, 183, 184, 186 through 189. Doubtless some of these numbers are not yet attached to names, while others with names are undeveloped agents thus far.
- b. Could you give us a brief summary covering the status of KIBITZ agents 1 through 26 on the U.S. side of the program? We have all the names and clearance situations, but we do not know too accurately which of these agents are regarded as still active.
- c. At your convenience we would also like to have a complete outline of how the various individual teams are shaping up. As an example, we know that KIBITZ 10 and 10a form a ready team and that team 118 is still on paper, but we would like to have (1) team leaders, (2) members of teams, and (3) stages of actual development of the teams.
