2. We have record of a Dr. Jui Jen Yu, who was with the Chinese Military Mission in Berlin on or about December 1947. Though the names are not spelled the same, it occurs to us that he may be identical with the Jen-Li-Jü mentioned in reference, since a member of our staff seems to recall that the proprietor of the Tai-Tung Restaurant (believed to be a dentist) mentioned in casual conversation that he had previously worked in Berlin in an official capacity for the Chinese Government.
