 SUBJECT: Missing File

1. It is requested that a notice be circulated within the EE Division along the following lines: It is requested that all safes in the EE Division be checked for a missing file labelled "KIBITZ 150-175". This file consists of a legal-sized green folder about 1 1/2" thick. It contains primarily personality data on sub-agents of KIBITZ-15.

2. A complete check of all safes in the EE/FIG Branch has been made as well as inquiries of persons who might have legitimate access to this file (EE/CE, EE/CFI, EE/FI/PO, FI/Plans, and EE/H). All searches to date have been negative. I suggest that the EE Notice also provide a date-line date by which all branches should report. I presume if the EE search is negative the next step will be the issuance of a DD/P Notice for a check of all files within the clandestine services. Attached is a copy of a memo from the case officer charged with custody of this file.
