<p>The conference of the MHEK leaders, which was held in Munich on 15 July 1950, took place mainly to reorganize that group. The MHEK, which was formerly the MHBSZ is the Magyar Harcosok Bajtarsi Kozossege of the Hungarian Front Fighters Union (formerly the Front Fighters Group).</p> <p>(Major General) Andras ZAKO is the President of the MHEK and his Adjutant is Lt. Ervin GEVAY (cover name FAGYINA). GEVAY is not identical with GEVAY-WOLFF, the Ministry Secretary. The MHEK is composed of the following sections:</p> <p>b. Press and Propaganda Section (Propaganda for MHEK contact with other political groups) - Chief is General Staff (Captain) Miklos v. KORPONAY, a radical rightist, but not a member of the Arrow Cross Party. KORPONAY is a friend of Lt. Colonel Gyorgy KOLLENYI (see below), a former member of the Hungarian Intelligence Service who was especially active in the Carpatho-Ukraine and Russia. KORPONAY received the difficult and dangerous task of diverting the attention of the leaders of the MHEK Intelligence Service and acting as if he had been given this task assignment (i.e. <i>intell head</i>)</p>				
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Reorganization of the Hungarian Front Fighters Group in Emigration continued.

It is worth noting that the MHEK intelligence representative in Salzburg is no longer Lt. Colonel Gyorgy KOLLENYI, but one PALFI (probably a cover name). KOLLENYI is now serving as a contact man to the G-organization. There is reportedly an understanding between KOLLENYI and the MHEK, whereby the former pays a regular sum to the MHEK and in return receives intelligence data. It is not known if KOLLENYI, in turn, furnished intelligence to the MHEK in addition to money, but there is a possibility that this is the case. The details of this agreement were reportedly worked out by KOLLENYI and KOPONAY.

Current information indicates that the MHEK receives funds not only from the French in Innsbruck, but also from an American source. Only Major General ZAKO, who was Director of the Hungarian Intelligence in 1944 knows what happened to the funds of the Hungarian Intelligence which were taken to Switzerland during the war.

As a result of the contact existing between Major General ZAKO and (Colonel General) Ferenc V. PARKAS DE KISBARNAK, there is a certain belief that PARKAS, as the senior Hungarian military official in emigration, will attempt to claim the leadership of the MHEK. (ZAKO, however, has a clear advantage while he has not opposed PARKAS politically, and thus he has found followers among all officers involved in Party politics.) One might say that PARKAS leads the older generation of the Hungarian Army, which is a smaller group, numerically, than the younger and more active elements ~~which~~ controlled by ZAKO.

The intelligence organization of Gyorgy KOLLENYI in Salzburg has at present the following leading members:

VISNOEK - KOLLENYI's representative.

Major ALBERT GOSSY - office work.

Lt. Lt. Sandor VISNYEY - offensive intelligence.

Capt. FERENCUSZ - defensive intelligence.

Col. (or Major) KOZIKELY - training and instruction of the agents.
