SUBJECT: GENERAL Operational
SPECIFIC KIBITZ Progress Report

1. The main point of this report is to inform Washington that with KIBITZ 15 1 1 (see para 3 for new code designation) now in his last few days of MISSOURI training we will have three complete stay-behind agent teams, namely, 6, 10, and 15 1 ready for assignment of equipment and signal plans. However, as MGK-A-31155 pointed out, the field problems conducted as the final phase of Commo training have shown the impracticability of our previous concept of small one- and two-man stay-behind teams. We therefore have directed KIBITZs 6 and 10 to flesh out their units to fuller operating strength, and to reorganize other KIBITZ personnel in order to beef up the manpower in each team.

2. An accompanying organizational chart shows some of the new line-ups, and in particular we call attention to the shift of KIBITZs 2, 4, and 5 to the KIBITZ 16 unit. For their own security we do not feel it necessary at this time to confirm this consolidation at their operational level. However, KIBITZ 16's operational brief will advise him of their availability in any manner he might need them. KIBITZ 2 he knows personally from community and business association and from being in the same sporting club. KIBITZ 4 will go along on anything with 2; and KIBITZ 5, whom 16 knows by sight can be picked up by 16 as his alternate radio operator as though under direction from me.

3. As for the KIBITZ 15 complex in the organizational chart, we wish to introduce the new code designations we will now be using in place of the former system of the letters of the alphabet and numbers (such as 15 1 2) which indicated leadership or subordination within the teams. This has become too unwieldy and meaningless as we reassign personnel to suit changing assessments and manpower needs. Further, being bound to the limits of the alphabet and hence withholding code designations to individuals under consideration, we appeared derelict in security and reporting. We trust you agree that the advantages of the new system of numbering KIBITZ 15 agents in series beginning with 101 straight through as they are recruited will far outweigh your trouble in changing your records according to the following. For clarity and ease in making these changes, we are where applicable, including the old code name with the new. This list is keyed in numerical sequence to the real names being forwarded in MGK-A-32196.


